Requirements to Enter: 2026 IHC (or provincial equivalent) membership, signed waiver and full payment prior to show. No numbers will be given out until these requirements are met.

Show Office: The Show office is located adjacent to the outdoor show ring. It will open at 8:00am on the day of the show and close approximately an hour after the last entrant has gone. Competitors must check in before entering the facility to receive their competitor package with ring numbers.

Warm-ups & Show Venue:

The show ring will be the main outdoor ring. There will be an area sectioned off on the far side of the show ring for warmups with jumps set up. The indoor area will also be available for warming up.

Prizes & Awards: Ribbons will be given for each class to 5th place unless otherwise stated and riders must complete an over fences class and the under-saddle class to be considered for Division Championships. Special Awards with prizes from our Sponsors will be offered to competitors.

Barn Rules:

- Please keep alleyways clean and clear. If you or your horse makes a mess, please clean up after yourself
- Overnight and day stalls must be stripped before hauling out
- Clean up manure and hay from around trailer before departing



General Competition Rules & Regulations:

- The abuse or inhumane treatment of a horse by an exhibitor, trainer, or other person shall not be tolerated. Such abuse of a horse may result in a penalty, forfeit of prizes, and asked to leave the show grounds.
- Pets MUST be on a leash at all times while on the show grounds and not disruptive to competitors or horses/ponies during the show. Owners must pick up and properly dispose of their pet's excrement.
- All over fence classes will have a 2-refusal limit before the rider is excused.
- The Show Committee and its Officials have the right to expel any rider, owner or spectator deemed to be in their sole discretion disruptive to the show at any time.
- Any horse that becomes out of control shall be eliminated from the competition at the discretion of the judge.

Refunds: Any refunds will be at the discretion of the Show Organizer and will be less the admin fee.

Facility: There will be a portable bathroom onsite. For those who have rented over night or day stalls, these will be in the Clinic Barn. It is located on the right-hand side of the driveway as soon as you enter. The main barn is designated for Up West Equestrian Barn Members only and is closed to the public and visiting riders except the indoor arena, which is available for warming up.

Ring Number: Each rider must always wear their ring number when mounted.

Classes:

Rider must complete at least one over fence class to be eligible for under saddle class. Show Organizer reserves the right to cancel or combine classes with 3 entrants or less.

Hunter Divisions

Walk/Trot: For inexperienced riders English or Western tack. Horses or Ponies. May also enter Poles on the Ground and X-Rails.

A: Walk Trot Pleasure – Judged on English pleasure horse/pony - to be shown at a flat-footed walk, normal trot. Light contact to be maintained. Judged on 45% performance, 40% manners, and 15% conformation.

B: Walk Trot Equitation - Judged on Turnout-25%, Hands & Seat-75%. Class 12B: Walk Trot Pleasure - Judged on Turnout-25%, Manners-75%.

Entry Fee: \$15 per class, no prize money

Walk/Trot/Canter: Designed for inexperienced junior exhibitors. Horses or ponies. Walk, trot and canter both ways. May also enter Hunter classes 18” and above, may not enter POGS or X-Rails.

A: Walk/Trot/Canter Pleasure - English pleasure horse/pony - to be shown at a flat-footed walk, normal trot and easy canter, not to gallop. Light contact to be maintained. Judged on 45% performance, 40% manners, and 15% conformation.

B: Walk/Trot/Canter Equitation – Judged on Turnout-25%, Hands & seat–75%

Entry Fee: \$15 per class; no prize money

Poles on the Ground Hunter: Open to Junior and Senior riders. Riders can only compete in W/T, and X-rails.
