Abegweit Series ICE (I Can Event) Eventing Derby Competition

Entry Options

Eventing Derby Competition Fees: \$75 all divisions. (*Admin, Abegweit, and medic fees are included in entry fees.)

- A Dressage Test and a Cross-Country Jumping Test per division
- Horses entered in the derby are restricted to one Division, but may also enter Class 1 of the Show Jumping Competition if desired.
- If you also enter the Jumping Competition, we will provide a day-end total of your combined Derby and Jumper Class scores to give you an overall placing at end of day for educational purposes, similar to a three-phase Horse Trial.
- EV100 Division: Unsanctioned "division" not part of the official competition, for Schooling and educational purposes only.
- U-Pick Division: Designed for those comfortable doing a higher-level dressage test but not wanting to jump as high. You can choose any of the listed dressage tests and Cross-Country test. Cross-Country height cannot be higher than what would normally be that tests height (or your Show Jumping height if also entering the Jumper Competition).
 (Example: If you enter a .85 Dressage test, you cannot do .90m Cross-Country.)

U-Pick Division	You pick any of the listed Dressage tests and Cross-Country tests. Cross-Country height cannot be higher than divisions normal height. (Example: If you enter a .85 Dressage test, you cannot do .90m Cross-Country.) When you enter, after adding this class, Click "Cart" and then the message icon to write what dressage test and XC height you want to do.

Abegweit Series Jumping Competition

Entry Options

Show Jumping Competition Fees: \$60 Division or \$30/class (*Admin, Abegweit, medic fees are included in entry fees.)

- Two classes (Class 1 & Class 2) per Division
- Horses are restricted from entering more than two Jumper Divisions (or four classes) total
- Horses also entered in the Derby may only enter Class 1 of the Jumper Competition. Jumper class can be any height you choose; cross-country can not be higher than the Jumper class height.

Class 1 – Optimum Time	Class 2 – Table A 220.2.1.2
The winning round is decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed (Jumping Faults + Time Faults). In the case of equality of faults, ties will be broken on the following basis: the time on course closest to the Optimum Time (over or under) will win, next closest next, etc. “Optimum Time” is defined as 4 seconds less than the Time Allowed for the course.	Against the Clock with a Time Allowed In the event of equality of Penalties for first place, there may be a jump-off Against the Clock judged under Table A. Other Athletes are placed according to their Penalties and time in the first round.

Non-Competitive Entry

If you wish to only school your horse onsite during the competition to introduce them to the atmosphere etc., you may enter the “non-compete schooling” option. This allows you to haul in to the site during the competition and hand-walk where allowed onsite or school your horse on the flat in the warm-up arena. Competitors have the right away. All competition rules and regulations must be followed.

Registration required and number must be worn on horse while onsite.

Cross-Country Schooling

The Cross-Country Course will be available for schooling on Saturday after the competition or Sunday if desired. Must be accompanied by a qualified coach. Entry Process

We are trying out a new online entering system. Entries will be processed online through [Equi-Go](#). Before you can enter you must complete the following: You will need to create an account, add a rider and upload a photo of rider's IHC membership to be verified. **This may take a day or two, do not wait till deadline day to do this!**

You'll then need to add a horse, and create a "team" to be able to enter. A "team" just means a horse & rider combination. A single horse & rider combination is considered a "duo" team. If one horse was being ridden by two riders, you would create a "trio" team, etc.

When going through the entry process, skip the SMS option. Thanks for your cooperation and please don't hesitate to reach out if you have any issues or questions with the process.

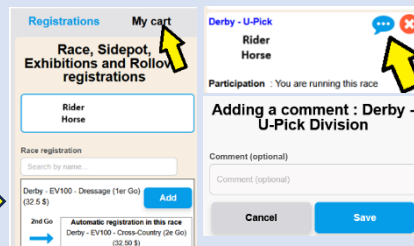

Entering U-Pick Division: After adding to your cart, go to your cart and select the message icon and then write in which dressage test and XC height.



Numbers

Please bring your own pinny holder if possible! If you do not have a holder, select the Pinny Deposit Fee when entering. Pinny/Number deposit is \$20, and will be refunded upon you returning the pinny/number.

If you have a pinny holder, your pinny number will be emailed to you for you to print off and bring with you.

Refunds

Before Deadline: full refund. After Deadline: less \$40 admin fee.

[Abegweit Series Rules](#) will be followed. Any rules not specifically addressed by the Abegweit rulebook will be covered by EC Rules. These competitions are Abegweit Series competitions and points earned will count toward Year-End awards. You must be an IHC member to qualify for those awards.

Entries improperly completed (missing fees, info, etc) are considered late if not updated before Closing Date.
