



Athlete Development Program Funding Assistance 2019-2022

One of Island Horse Council's goals is to provide Athlete, Coach, and Officials Development programs to all members regardless of discipline. Providing funding opportunities to assist IHC members to attend athlete development activities locally as well as out of province, is one part of these programs.

Eligible activities for which athletes may apply for funding assistance under the Athlete Development Program are listed below.

Requests for funding must be submitted with the appropriate application form within the designated application period. Funding will be approved on a first-come, first-served basis, and will be based on the request's alignment with Island Horse Council's mission and the Long Term Athlete Development program.

Athletes may apply for up to 50% of expenses associated with eligible athlete development activities. If applications are approved, athletes will be eligible to receive up to \$150 per member. IHC reserves the right to determine what percentage they will approve or to deny an application.

Deadline for Applications: April 15th, 2022

Eligible activities include:

- Training camps, clinics, or courses, travel expenses for off-Island Inter-provincial or National level competitions.

IHC will not provide funding for:

- Competition entry fees, memberships or sponsorships.

Application Requirements

- You must have already attended your event.
- Event must have taken place between April 1st, 2019 and March 31st, 2022.
- The application form and supporting documents must be completed in full and submitted to IHC by the listed deadline. Declare any other sources of income for the event (grants, sponsors, etc)
- Proof of Attendance attached (copy of receipts or proof of payment with your name on an attendance list).
- Application must be submitted within the qualifying period.
- One application per event. Submit a separate application for each event.

Applicant Criteria:

- Must be a current IHC member in good standing
- Must be a PEI resident
